In 2003 I met John as a consultant managing the City of Chicago's All-Hazard Mitigation Plan (the first large city, all-hazards mitigation plan in the United States). Throughout this engagement John and I had many conversations about the profession of emergency management, as well as the industry that was emerging from 9/11 and the relics of the civil defense era. We shared the excitement of an emerging profession as well as the frustrations that came from an industry that had become complacent, lacked innovation, and was slow to acknowledge the disaster science and research that had been developed over the past century. Unlike other consulting firms that offered emergency management services as yet another of their many professional consulting service business lines, we saw the need for a firm that specializes purely in emergency management. Most importantly, we saw a need for an organization that could serve as a beacon for driving the industry with innovation, applied research, client-focused results, and excellence.

On a warm fall day after our meeting at 333 State Street in Chicago, our discussions led to the idea of Integrated Solutions Consulting. In just a few months, ISC became a corporation and just a few months after that, we landed our first projects with University of Chicago, Seminole Tribe of Florida, Chicago Department of Public Health, DuPage County, and the FEMA Public Assistance TAC. In 2007, we made our first early investments in the Odysseus™ Enterprise System (OES) and we hired our first employees, including Lauren and Daiko. Through grit, determination, sleepless nights, and too many sacrifices to count, we relished the opportunity to grow ISC into the organization it is today with contracts from coast to coast and border to border with all levels of government. Beyond the many triumphs, most satisfying for me was to take this journey with someone I respect and trust.
